Here is an outline of the exciting learning opportunities your child will experience next week, including how this could be supported further at home.



Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had another busy and successful week. We have been very impressed with the children's attitude to learning and their determination. We had a visit from Sally 'the brush bus lady' and she was very impressed with our tooth brushing technique.

This week we started exploring the story of 'The Little Red Hen' and have created a story map with actions. We will be continuing this next week and hope to make our own bread.

In maths, we have been continuing to learn about how to partition numbers. We have been talking about the numbers 2, 3 and 4 and looking for patterns and making links.

In phonics next week we will be learning the sounds **r**, **j**, **v**, **y**, **w**. We will continue to learn how to say the sounds in a word and then blend sounds together. For example, "c-a-t...cat, b-a-d...bad". We will use the magnetic boards to spell CVC words (consonant, vowel, consonant).
