Topic: RE – What does it mean to belong to a faith community?

**Duration: 6 weeks** 

This half term, our focus is to answer the question 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?' The term 'faith community' refers to a group of people (of any size) that live near each other and follow the same religious traditions.

## What I already know:

Children will already know:

- Christianity as part of a growing sense of self, their own community, and their place within it.
- Some religious stories making connections with personal experiences.
- That Christians believe in God.
- That Christmas and Easter are important Christian celebrations.

Making sense of belief	Understanding the impact.	E Connecting
Understand we all belong to something and why belonging is an important part of our lives.  Describe what Christians believe about God caring for them and learn about the Lost Coin and Lost Sheep parables.	What a story about the prophet shows about belonging to the Muslim community and understand how calligraphy shows what is important to Muslims.  Why many Christian families baptise their babies and look for similarities and differences on how babies are welcomed into the Islamic faith.  Understand more about elements of Christian and Jewish weddings, rings, and vows.  Know why people choose to make promises to one another when they get married.	Think, talk, and ask questions about whether they can learn anything from the story for themselves, exploring different ideas.  Give a reason for the ideas they have and the connections they make.
