Maths—In Year 1 we will be using what we have learnt about place value and addition and subtraction of numbers to 10 to help us move on to place value and addition and subtraction of numbers up to 20. We will also be learning about position and direction within geometry.

In year 2 we are going to be learning addition and subtraction, building to adding and subtracting any 2 digit number from and to 2 digit numbers.

School Value



This half term, we are learning about Responsibility, by taking care with our learning and looking after our classroom environment. We are also thinking about looking after our friends and others.

British Value



This half term, in our Class Assemblies and PSHE lessons, we are learning about the British Value of Tolerance, by understanding about different cultures and accepting others opinions.

Our Curriculum- Children in Key Stage 1 and 2 will enjoy a long and short enquiry each half term.

A long enquiry typically lasts five weeks and allows us to teach a subject, such as history, in depth. Clear expectations of what will be learned, is shared with parents and pupils through a Knowledge Organiser. At the end of the work, we plan to use Enquiry Quizzes on our iPads to see how much each child has remembered.

Our first Learning Enquiry this term is Geography—How does the Weather affect our lives? The children will explore different types of weather and learn how to measure some types of weather and keep records of weather. They will compare the weather in different seasons and compare the weather in two different locations around the world. The Knowledge Organiser is attached. Please use it to reinforce and repeat the learning at home.

Short Enquiries

A short enquiry can last anything from 1-3 days and adds breadth to our curriculum.

Our short enquiry will have a Music focus. We will be learning to sing, act, and perform to an audience in readiness for our Christmas performance 'The Lucky Owl'.
