
The Powerful Knowledge we will take away from this Learning Enquiry (what children will be learning):

Pentecost

Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after Easter and is when Christians remember the gift of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the third part of the Trinity - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - which is how Christians understand God and is the means by which God is active on Earth.

Acts

Acts tells the story of the Early Christian church, with particular interest for the ministry of the Twelve Apostles and of Paul of Tarsus. The early chapters in Jerusalem, report Jesus's Resurrection, his Ascension, the Day of Pentecost, and the start of the Twelve Apostles' ministry.

Christian

Christians are people who believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, and who follow his teachings and those of the Christian churches that grew up after his death.

Bible

The religious, sacred text of Christians.


### What I already know:
