Festive Fun

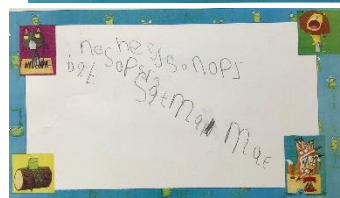
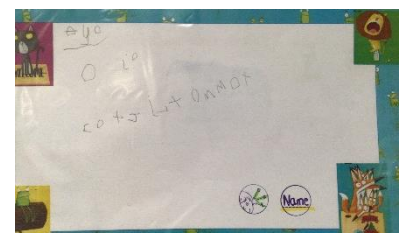
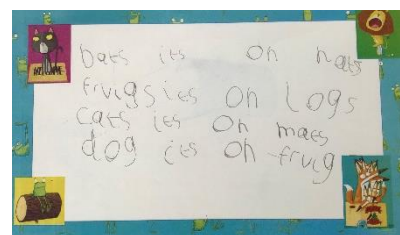
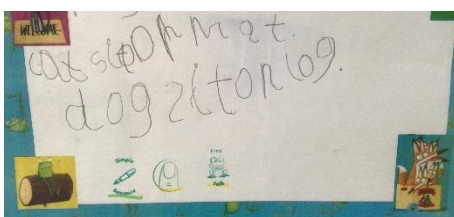
